Dr Rebecca Millman is a Senior Lecturer in the Manchester Centre for Audiology and Deafness, The University of Manchester. Rebecca is a hearing scientist who is committed to delivering research that will advance our understanding of how human brains respond to sounds that provide important cues for communication and improve the lives of people with hearing loss.

Rebecca is currently the lead for the “Hearing and Brain Health” programme in the National Institute for Health and Care Research Manchester Biomedical Research Centre within the “Hearing Health” theme. Rebecca is also a senior researcher in the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Industrial Doctoral Network “EASYLI: Easy Listening – Optimizing the consequences of effortful listening in occupational settings”.

Rebecca has been a member of the British Society of Audiology (BSA) Cognition in Hearing Special Interest Group (CH SIG) since 2016 and served as CH SIG Chair from 2021-2024. Rebecca established the international BSA Dementia Network which provides support and recommendations for good practice for audiologists and hearing scientists working with people with dementia.
