

Workshop 2A ABSTRACT

Title: Collaborative discussions of infant ABR/ASSR assessment protocols and early hearing program outcomes

Abstract: The purpose of this workshop is to engage international early hearing programs in discussions about infant ABR/ASSR threshold protocols and program outcomes within a collaborative and respectful environment.

Learner objectives:

- To increase awareness of the differences and similarities between infant ABR/ASSR threshold protocols through discussion of selected protocol questions
- To support collaborative discussions on how practices can be adjusted in accordance with the majority of available evidence
- To learn from one another with the aim of improving infant ABR/ASSR threshold assessment protocols and patient outcomes
- To create opportunities for new collaborations

We recognize the diversity of research and training in the field. This workshop is about working towards a common view based on the overall body of evidence. By attending this workshop, you agree to share ABR/ASSR protocols and data (if available), come with a growth mindset, and be respectful of each other. Open discussion is encouraged to ensure different perspectives are considered. Our goal is to have participation from a broad representation of international programs.
